This course is for those that require this skill in their current or future workplace. Cannulation is a skill that requires good coordination, knowledge of anatomy of veins and arms and strict infection control.

The course is offered as a one day program at both our Harris Park (NSW) and St Kilda (Vic) Training Centres or we can arrange on-site training at your place of work for 4 or more participants.

On successful completion of this course you will be awarded an Accredited Statement of Attainment for the unit: “*Perform intravenous cannulation for sample collection HLTPAT409C*” towards Certificate IV in Pathology HLT41807. This is a Nationally Recognised Qualification.

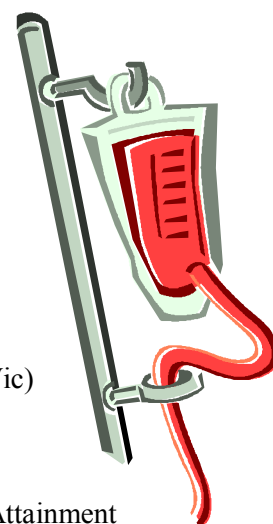
If you do not meet the above criteria we may recommend that you undertake our 2 day venepuncture training course before you book into cannulation. Please contact our office or check our website for course dates.
