Drug Urine Testing AS/NZS4308:2008

To meet the needs of the industry, Adept Training provides formal industry training for Urinary Drug Screening as per AS/NZS4308:2008. "Recommended practice for the collection, detection and quantitation of drugs of abuse in urine".

We have developed a training program that we believe is cost and time effective for organisations requiring accredited training for their staff.

Face-to-face training can be delivered on site or at our training facility in Harris Park NSW. Given the concerns expressed by organisations about the cost and impracticality of sending all staff to an interstate location, we have also developed a distance based program. We can work in conjunction with an appropriate company representative who will complete the face-to-face training with Adept and is then authorised to complete assessments for other workers within the organisation.

Oral Fluids Drug Testing AS/NZS4760-2006

Adept Training can also provide customised training for "procedures for specimen collection and the detection and quantitation of drugs in oral fluid" (saliva testing).

Alcohol Breathalyser Testing

Breathalyser testing is becoming increasingly popular; we can add breathalyser training to a program if required.



Option 1 – you come to us

Training delivered at our facility in Harris Park NSW. Appropriate time and date will be arranged.
Fees: \$440 per participant
Time: ½ day (9am – 1.30pm)
Minimum: 2

Option 2 – we come to you

Training delivered onsite at your workplace. Appropriate time and date will be arranged.
Fees: \$550 per participant
Time: ½ day (times may be negotiated)
Minimum: 4
Travel costs for trainer to deliver on site will be added to invoice.

Option 3 – complete the training & assess your own staff

Distance based training – this model allows participants to undertake the training through a blended learning model. Workbooks will be issued to each participant to work through. Written assessment tasks along with an assessment from an appropriate person must be completed to achieve competency and receive the Certificate.

Pre-requisite: This option can only be utilised where an appropriate representative of the organisation has been trained by Adept Training and is competent to perform assessments.

This model has been developed to maximise efficiency and cost effectiveness for organisations with staff over large geographical areas.

On successful completion of the training session and assessment tasks participants will be awarded a Statement of Attainment for *HLTPAT304B Collect pathology specimens other than blood*, one unit of competency towards the HLT32607 Certificate III in Pathology. This qualification is recognised within the Australian Qualifications Framework.
