

## Perform Blood Collecting – HLTPAT306B

This competency is delivered as part of the Certificate III in Pathology (HLT32607) or participants may choose to undertake the competency separately where they meet prerequisites.

Prerequisites: You must have English literacy and numeracy skills equivalent to Cert III in English, IELTS 5.0 or undertake Adept English Assessment. If you are unsure of whether you are eligible, please contact our office and we can arrange for an interview. Students must have suitable previous experience in a health care environment.

We recommend that you possess one of the following;

- previous experience collecting venous blood samples in a health care environment
- an overseas medical background or qualification
- health care professional needing to collect blood samples for their current work

Perform blood collecting (venepuncture) is delivered over two days, you will learn all aspects of blood collecting including; basic anatomy and physiology, the use of the tourniquet, how to use vacutainer and scalp vein needles and how to identify veins and take blood samples while maintaining professionalism, safety and infection control guidelines. Work performed requires a broad knowledge base and the ability to apply solutions to a defined range of unpredictable problems. Individuals will take responsibility for their own work and limited responsibility for the quantity and quality of work of others. All tasks are conducted in accordance with organisational policies and procedures including OHS and infection control guidelines. Assessment for safety, accuracy & responsibility in the workplace are critical aspects of this unit.

There are great employment opportunities available for experienced blood collectors. We liaise directly with most of the major pathology laboratories, recruitment organisations and Health and they recruit students straight out of our courses for employment in the pathology and health care sectors.

The cost of the course is \$700.00 (no concessions) 10% discount applies when fees are paid in full 7 days before course commences. You will be provided with your course manual (*prior to the course commencing*), course notes, and all equipment. Fees must be paid in full when booking in to the course. Students must complete their pre-course work before attending the class. Closed shoes must be worn to participate in clinical sessions.



When you successfully complete the course you will be awarded with a Statement of Attainment for the competency Perform Blood Collecting. This is a Nationally Recognised Qualification as part of Certificate III in Pathology.

We have a great time during the course but we do ask for your participation during practical venepuncture and role play. You will take blood from real people, not just simulated material.
